Coming from Austin

Take Highway 290 west out of Austin toward Johnson City Cross RR12 and Highway 290 intersection in Dripping Springs Continue west on Highway 290 west for 1.2 miles
Turn left (south) onto Roger Hanks Parkway

Coming from Johnson City

Head South on Highway 281
Turn left (east) on Highway 290 toward
Turn right (south) onto Roger Hanks Parkway

Coming from Wimberley

Head north on Ranch Road 12 toward Dripping Springs Turn left (west) on Highway 290
Drive west on Highway 290 for 1.2 miles Turn left (south) onto Roger Hanks Parkway

Coming from Bee Cave and Lakeway

Head north on Highway 71
Turn left (west) on Hamilton Pool Road
Turn left (south) on Ranch Road 12
Turn right (west) on Highway 290 West
Drive west for 1.2 miles on Highway 290 West Turn left (south) onto Roger Hanks Parkway
